This checklist is designed to assist customers implementing the Liberty Mutual/Coventry PPP.

You must complete the following requirements:

<p>1. Distribute the following documents in electronic or print format to all Illinois employees:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Notice of Workers Compensation Preferred Provider Program (PPP) advisory form. <p><i>We recommend each employer document the method of delivery, to whom the documents were delivered, the location of the delivery, and the date(s) of delivery.</i></p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>2. Post the Notice of Workers Compensation Preferred Provider Program (PPP) advisory form in a conspicuous location at each of your Illinois locations.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>3. Provide the Notice of Workers Compensation Preferred Provider Program (PPP) advisory form to all new employees hired after your initial enrollment period.</p> <p><i>We recommend completing this as a part of the new employee onboarding and within three (3) business days of hire. Consider including these documents as part of your new hire packet.</i></p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>4. When an occupational injury or illness is reported you should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Provide the Notice of Preferred Provider Program For Workers Compensation Medical Care form to the injured or ill worker. – Direct the injured worker to a PPP provider. – Report the claim to Liberty Mutual Insurance immediately. <p><i>If an emergency, call 911 or seek immediate medical care as appropriate.</i></p>	<input type="checkbox"/>



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
